as *Widow Corney (the Matron)*

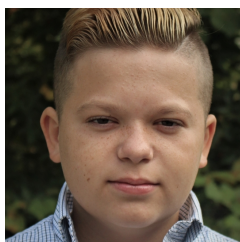

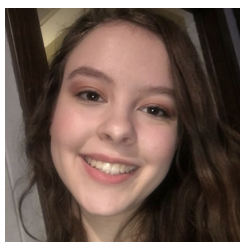

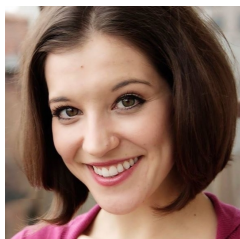

as Bill Sikes

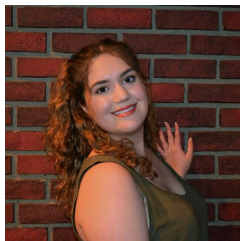

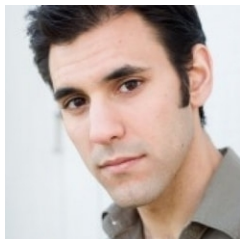

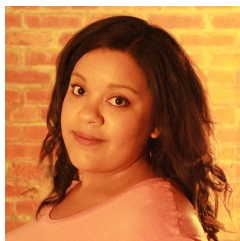


Michael Sherry
